MINUTES - GENERAL MEETING – MARCH 9, 2011

Diane Townsend, President, called the meeting to order at 7:15 PM. Kate Barton made a motion to dispense with the reading of the minutes. Tammy Vachon seconded. Motion carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT –Barb Croy, Treasurer, reported that FWOTC has \$16,700.00 in various accounts. The club has made \$3,388.26 since June 1, 2010.

1st VICE PRESIDENT

Karen Smallwood, 1st Vice President, reported on the Spring Obedience Trial which is Saturday May 7th and Sunday May 8th. Closing date for the trial entries is April 20th at noon. This year we are having a new class – Beginners Novice and our trial will be open to mixed breeds. For mixed breeds, entrants must have AKC paperwork and number prior to trial entry. There will be a 'C' match on Friday May 6th. A 'C' match is a good way to practice in a trial atmosphere. The 'C' match will run from 6:30 PM to 9:30PM and entry closing date is April 27th. Dean Lund is the chief ring steward this year and will be looking for volunteers to work the trial. There will also be a raffle again this year to help offset the cost of the trial. Trophy donations are needed to pay for high combined and high in trail. Kate Barton asked members to take premiums to any trial they are attending and distribute them.

2nd VICE PRESIDENT

Bonnie Kellams, 2nd Vice President, was absent. She will be ordering from J&J fairly quickly, so club members are urged to put their orders in tonight. Sign up papers are available.

CLUB MEMBER DOT

Dean Lund, Club Member DOT reported that most classes were full. All confirmations will go out in the next few days. Dean reported that she is trying to arrange a dog first aid class with the Red Cross. Dean reported that she had put out signup sheets for workers for the trial. Wednesday, May 4th from 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM will be mat clean up and Thursday May 5th from 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM will be for set up. Friday May 6th is the C match and sweeping mats. Trial will run on Saturday May 7th and Sunday May 8th. Club members were encouraged to sign up even if they are not sure what they are doing as there will be training available. There will be no class on Wednesday of that week. Dean reminded members that we will need to sweep and roll mats on Sunday after the trial.

AGILITY – DOT

Lisa Fair, Agility DOT, reported that most classes were full. She stressed attendance as a way to assure club members of a spot in the classes. Club T-shirts have been created and will be ordered tomorrow.

PUBLIC CLASS – DOT

Lynn Swager, Public DOT reported that all trainers have been found for the coming session.

TRACKING DOT

Pam Johnson was absent. Tracking DOT reported that there will be 2 tracking classes, one advanced and one beginners. These were listed in the Barking Times. Pam reported that the chiropractic day made \$300 for the club. She also reported that Paul Hellings will be at the club on April 19th and 20th. In October there will be a TD and a VST (Variable Surface Tracking) trial. This will be the first VST offered in Indiana.

CORRESPONDING SECRETARY

Sharon Kersjes reported that she has registered 7 puppies for the puppy class, sixteen dogs for the 7:15 class and 3 dogs for the 8:00 class.

PRESIDENT

Diane Townsend announced that there would be no class on May 4th. The Canine Good Citizen test will be April 27th. The club now has a weather radio at the building. It is located in the top drawer in the obedience room. Tuesday nights this next session will be for run throughs, which are practice for the May Trial. The club has purchased a new A-frame which is very light as well as the new teeter with the rubber.

The club is looking for members to sit at the booth. These members should not have to pay entrance fees but would have to pay for parking. The Fort Wayne ASPCA is sponsoring this event. They will have events throughout the day one of which will be world champion flying disc dogs. They have asked us to perform an agility demo as well as an Obedience demo and a Question and Answer session entitled "My dog won't listen". There will be several rescue groups and vendors there. 4. Please keep in mind that the Subnovice class is offered each session and the people coming out of the public classes will be given priority over club members.
5. Anyone instructing and/or assisting a class will also be given priority when signing up for classes. This is a perk for volunteering to teach a class.
6. If you try to sign up for a class and it is full, you will be put on a waiting list in case someone drops out of that class.
7. If nobody drops the class, then those people on the waiting list will be given priority over other club members for the next session.

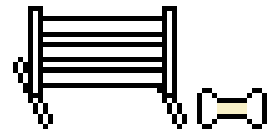

It gives people who have come to set up for the night classes a chance to work their dogs. Set up starts at 10 am. Please come early and have your dogs and crates in before that time. You need to help set up to run your dogs. New people to the morning session must be OK'd by the Agility DOT.

**5:00 pm to 6:15 Instructor's time** This time is for instructors to work their dogs and work their class lessons.

**6:15pm to 7 Open and Excellent.** This class is for people currently showing in Open or Excellent. Limit 12

**7pm to 7:45 Intro to Agility** This class is for teams that are coming out of the Tuesday Beginning Agility class or for dogs not comfortable with weaves or the contacts. Limit 12

**7:45 to 8:30 Intermediate Handling** This class for teams that the dogs and handlers need continued work on handling cues and common agility sequences. Limit 12

## FWOTC Board Descriptions

**President** – Preside over all Club meetings and the executive committee. Represent the Club where requested and/or desired. Review and oversee all Club activities. Appoint committees. Maintain order.

**1<sup>st</sup> Vice President** – Preside and exercise the duties of the President in their absence. Serve as the Club's obedience trial chairman and appoint all special committees connected with the obedience trial.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President** – Preside and exercise the duties of the President in their absence. They will have the responsibility and care of all the Club's training equipment.

**Treasurer** – Establish and maintain a true record of all club monies received and disbursed from or to any person or source. Make payments as authorized. Prepare the annual budget. Prepare any and all tax documents.

**Recording Secretary** – Make and maintain a permanent record of each meeting of the Club and all Executive committee meetings. Collect club member dues. Exercise the duties of the Corresponding Secretary in their absence.

**Corresponding Secretary** – Retrieve messages and/or requests from the Club voicemail. Forward all training applications as requested. Receive money for training classes. Notify training applicants of their acceptance, date and location of training sessions. Take care of all Club correspondence. Exercise the duties of the Recording Secretary in their absence.

**Club Director of Training** – Plan and organize all Club member training classes for each session. Find trainers for these classes. Supervise that evening of classes. Forward a list of instructors and class members to the person in charge of paws points.

**Agility Director of Training** – Plan and organize all Club member training classes for each session. Find trainers for these classes. Supervise that evening of classes. Forward a list of instructors and class members to the person in charge of paws points.

**Public Director of Training** – Organize training classes for each session. Find trainers for these classes. Supervise that evening of classes. Teach public classes as required. Sell equipment to the class members as required. Forward a list of instructors to the person in charge of paws points.

**Tracking Director of Training** – Plan and organize all Club member tracking classes as needed. Forward a list of instructors and class members to the person in charge of paws points. Organize tracking tests and seminars.

**Board Members** – Serve as required. Help out with committees, classes, etc.
