AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color). Beagles (not exceeding 13 in. over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.). Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard), Collies (rough, smooth).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rules refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).

Drawing Of Entries For TD Test:

September 16, 2009 at 7:00 PM DST

A drawing to fill entry limits will be held at the Allen County Fairgrounds, 2726 Carroll Road, Fort Wayne, IN. The drawing shall be random among all entries received except that preference will be given to dogs that do not hold a TD title. When the advertised limit has been drawn, all remaining entries shall be drawn and assigned a position on the alternate list in the order in which they were drawn. All entrants will be notified of the results of the draw by mail. E-mail and telephone inquiries are welcomed. **TD Certification must accompany each entry for any dog that has not previously passed an AKC Tracking Dog test.**

Upon notification, alternates shall have the option of accepting or refusing the opportunity to participate in the test. In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, the first alternate entry present according to the order in which they were drawn shall assume the vacant position.

Entry Information

No entry fees will be refunded except the entry fee for an entry that pulls before the closing date; or an entry and/or alternate that does not participate when another alternate is present to replace him/her prior to the track draw. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. Entries will not be accepted without fee. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Test Secretary will add the fee charged by the bank to the amount of each returned check. Faxed, telephone, E-mail, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC form and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry forms are not acceptable. No refunds for duplicate entries or errors on entry blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in filling out entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Bitches in season may participate in this test in accordance with Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking Regulations. Entry fees and certifications shall be returned in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 12 of the AKC Tracking Regulations. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Judge or barred from competition by action of Tracking Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or acts beyond control of FWOTC and/or the Tracking Committee it is impossible to open or to complete the test, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable disease and have appropriate vaccinations.

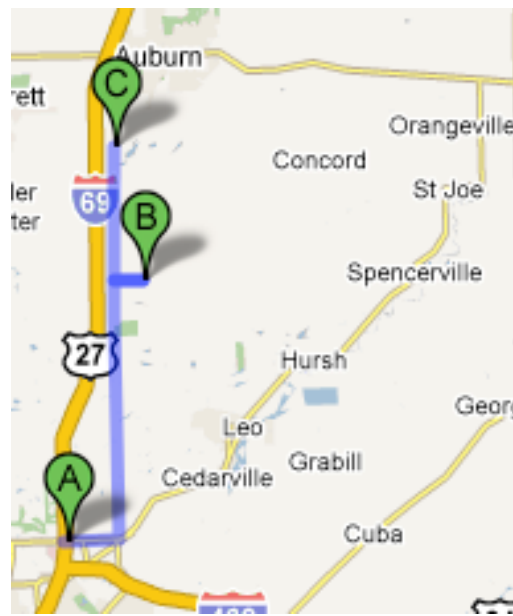
