NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are under control and are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered into the show. All entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and must include the Agreement and Rules. No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
- Handlers in Regular classes may opt to run in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Preferred dogs must jump in the required height division.
- **Bitches in season** are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. **Please note:** Refund of entry fees, for bitches entered in the trial that are in season during the dates of this show, may be obtained by sending a veterinarian's certificate to the trial secretary before the start of the trial (10-21-2011 0800). Entry fees will be refunded minus \$8.00/per run per day, includes AKC fee and administration fees.
- Injured dogs are not permitted to compete in agility trials. Refund is the same as for bitches in season.
- Head Halters, Pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited on the trial grounds. Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. **Judges are not required to wait for dogs.** The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs. **Please** help us keep this site and hotels clean for future use.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a **\$40** collection fee to the amount of each returned check. You will also be placed on our *Do not accept entry* until entry and fees paid.
- Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis. No refunds will be given for less than \$10.00.
- AVMA Statement: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- *** Waterproof Tarp is needed under crates and Waterproof Tarp and padding under Exercise Pens. Protect turf please.**

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind or deaf dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

Owners are responsible for entering their dogs in the proper height division.

Jump Height Card Process

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog *before* its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. **It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.**

After Closing wait list AKC rule change, effective Sept. 1, 2010 (Ch 1, section 16)

FWOTC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing Friday, Oct 7 at 6:pm. A maximum of 20 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to Friday, October 7, 2011 at 6:00pm. Any entries withdrawn that are received by Saturday, October 15, 12:00pm, will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by Saturday, October 15th will receive a full refund.

This event will be held indoors at The Plex South. This inflatable golf dome offers 60,000 sq. feet of Rubber Beaded soccer turf fields. **It has a revolving door entrance.** We will be offering 3 rings that will be at least 90 x 120 feet. Rings are gated with wooden obedience gates and PVC framed snow fencing. There is plenty of crating space available. The Plex South has air conditioning. The facility is close to restaurants, hotels and has plenty of grassy walking area surrounding the facility.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
